

What size stones do I need?

Octopus Setting



You'll need 16 round stones measuring 2.5mm in diameter for this octopus set ring



You'll need 8 round stones measuring 3.5mm in diameter for this octopus set ring



You'll need 2 round stones measuring 3.5mm in diameter, 4 round stones measuring 3mm in diameter and 5 round stones measuring 2.5mm in diameter for this octopus set ring

Flush Setting



For this ring you can use various sizes of round stones from 1mm to 2.5mm in diameter



For this ring you can use various sizes of round stones from 1mm to 3.5mm in diameter



For this ring you can use various sizes of round stones from 1mm to 4mm in diameter



For this ring you can use various sizes of round stones from 1mm to 4mm in diameter

Bezel Setting



You'll need 1 round stone measuring 7mm in diameter for this bezel (tapered tube) ring



You'll need 1 oval stone measuring 10 x 8mm for this bezel set ring



You'll need 1 square stone measuring 6mm (6.5mm will also work) for this bezel set ring



You'll need 14 round stones measuring approximately 2.5 - 3mm in diameter for this bezel set ring



You'll need 13 square stones measuring 3mm for this bezel set ring



You'll need 3 oval stones measuring 4 x 6mm for this bezel set ring

IMPORTANT

The sizes mentioned are approximate, there is definitely a little wiggle room. For flush setting it is important to measure the depth of the stone and ensure this is not deeper than the thickness of the metal the stone is being set in.
